Sunnylands

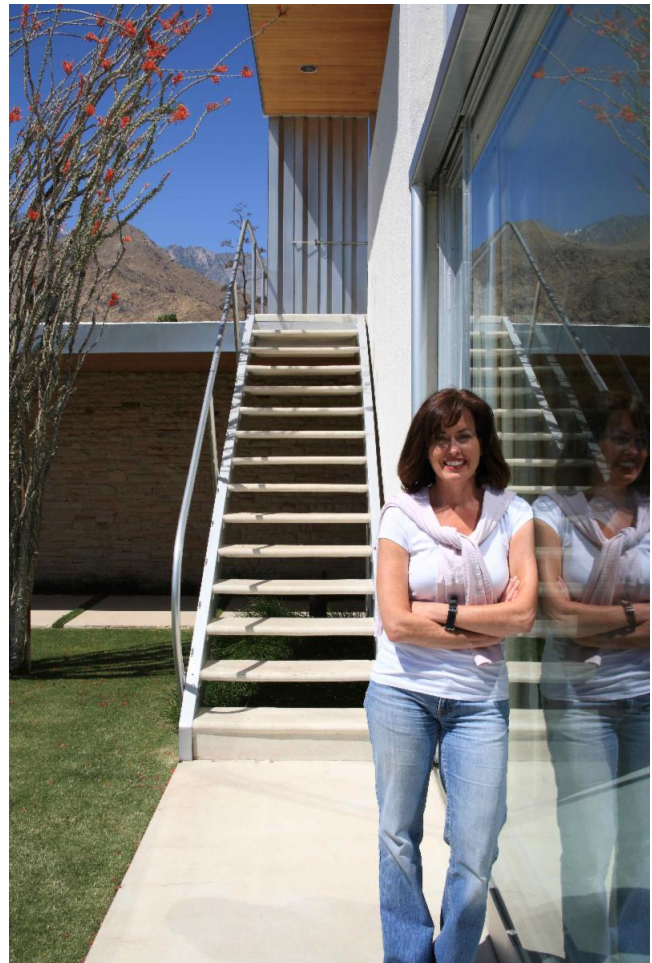
